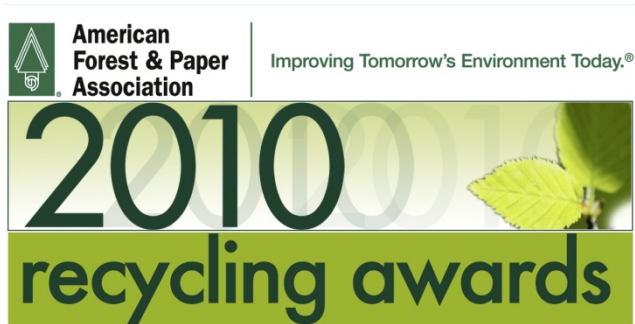

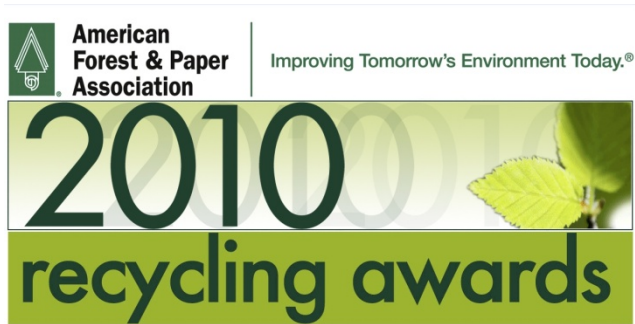
The award winner, who will receive a \$2,000 cash prize, will be announced in March and promoted at the national and local levels and on the paperrecycles.org website.

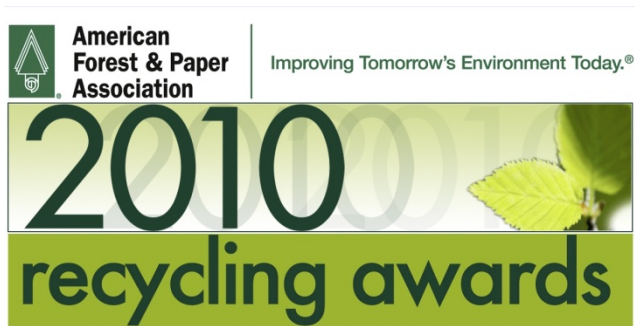
